
Dear Sir,

This has reference to your letter RTI/UNI/FAA/734 (Communication 2) dated 5th December 2019, received today.

While we have been advised that the Right to Information Act is not applicable to the Private Universities, without prejudice and reserving our rights, we provide the desired information as under:

1. The University is approved by UGC U/s 2(f). No other approvals are required for running the programmes.
2. We do not have any Scholarship Scheme exclusively for the students of J&K. We have our own merit scholarship as well as Financial Aid Scheme based on the family income and is applicable to all the students.
3. We do not have special scholarship for minority community. As said above, our scholarship scheme is applicable to all the students. Government of Gujarat has a Scholarship Scheme called "Mukhya Mantri Scholarship Scheme".
4. Our admission criteria is common for all students. There is no special criteria for J&K. It is based on holistic evaluation of academic performance in qualifying examination, statement of purpose to be written by the student, personal interaction and other special achievements in Sports, Arts etc. For the professional, Courses like MBA and Engineering, the admissions are regulated under the Fees and Admissions Act of Government of Gujarat.
5. Students pass out in 12th with Physics, Chemistry and Maths are eligible for Engineering and Life Science Programmes, subject to admission process as explained above.
