With reference to your First Appeal as mentioned, above, the reply is submitted as under :

- The reply to your RTI Application No. RTI/UNI/466 dated 14th October, 2019 has already been replied vide our letter no. GLAU/RO/F.11/RTI/8513/2019 dated 1st November, 2019, and you might have received the same but nothing has been mentioned by you about the reply which was sent by our University. A copy of the reply is attached herewith for your information as Annexure 'A'
- 2. Details of all government recognition is attached herewith, which are already available on the website of the University (www.gla.ac.in), you may fetch the details and download the same. Details attached as **Annexure** 'B'...
- 3. GLA University is a Private University and receives no grant-in-aid either from the State or Central Government, therefore, at present, there are no such Scholarship schemes for the students from Jammu & Kashmir to take admission in our University. However, they if they take admission in our University and take advantage for the 'Special Scholarship Scheme for the students of Jammu & Kashmir as per the Guidelines issued by Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, they may apply and take advantage of the same and for that our University has no objection. A copy of the Guideline issued by Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education (Scholarship Division) is attached herewith as Annexure 'C'
- 4. There is no such scheme for the students belonging to minority communities to take admission in our University especially for the Students of Jammu and Kashmir but in general, the University provides the Scholarship only in B.Tech Program with Rs. 33,000/- p.a. for candidates with more than 90% marks, Rs. 25,000/- p.a. candidates with 80.89% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at 10+2 level as per eligibility requirement. The Scholarship on the basis of JEE-MAINS percentile are also provided to the candidates i.e. 95-100 Rs. 74,000/-, 90.94.99 Rs. 37,000/- and 85 89.89 Rs. 20,000/- but the student has to maintain a minimum CPI of 8.00 to avail scholarship in the next year of his/her studies. (Sae prospectus Details of Courses offered. Copy attached as Annexure 'D'. Further, the students belong to Jammu & Kashmir, may also apply for the Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme for Students of Jammu and Kashmir (PMSSS).

- 5. If a student from Jammu & Kashsmir fulfills the eligibility criteria, h/she may be given admission in all curses aver and above the university's sanctioned intake. The admissions in our University are always open to all students of any State including Jammu and Kashmir, and if any student who apply and wants to take admission, the admission may be given to him or her. For admission, every year, the Advertisements are issued in all the National Newspapers.
- 6. The student who pass out his/her 12th in Physics, Chemistry, Maths from the National Board of School Education, J&K, there are various courses, details are provided in the prospects. A copy of Prospectus is attached herewith; you may read the contents about the courses in Annexure D.
- 7. The name and list of all the courses being offered by University is provided in the prospectus alongwith the fee structure.

All the information desired under RTI Act, 2005 are being provided and we hope that the same will suffice your query.





GUIDELINES FOR THE 'SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR JAMMU & KASHMIR

1. OBJECTIVE

The Special Scholarship Scheme for Jammu & Kashmir aims at encouraging the youth from Jammu & Kashmir to take advantage of the educational institutions outside the state, which would provide them an opportunity, to interact with their counterparts from the rest of the country, thereby helping them become a part of the mainstream.

2. SCOPE

It is envisaged to provide 5000 fresh scholarships per annum. Out of these, 2070 scholarships are for General Degree Courses, 2830 for Professional/Technical courses and 100 for Medical Courses. There is a provision of inter-changeability of slots among General, Medical and Professional/Technical streams, subject to the savings accruing from any shortfall in the number of students opting for General Degree Courses.

3. RATE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The components of scholarship under this scheme are as under:

Academic Fees:

Up to Rs. 30000 per annum for General Degree courses.

OR

Up to Rs. 1.25 Lakhs per annum for Professional/Technical courses.

OR

Up to Rs. 3.00 Lakhs per annum for Medical courses, including Bachelor of Dental Surgery (B.D.S).

Scholarship towards Academic Fees is disbursed as per actuals or as per the fee fixed by the State Fee Regulatory Authority, whichever is lesser and within the overall ceiling.

In addition to this, fixed Maintenance Allowance of Rs. 1.0 Lakh is provided to all the selected students irrespective of the course. The Maintenance Allowance is disbursed in two installments. Release of second instalment is subject to his/her submission of continuation certificate, duly certified by the Institution.

4. ELIGIBILITY

The students of Jammu & Kashmir having family income of less than Rs.8.0 lakh per annum [issued by DoPT O.M. No. 36033/1/2013-Estt. (Res.), dated 13.09.2017] and have passed class XII from the State are eligible to apply under the scheme. Polytechnic Diploma holders from the recognized Polytechnic Institutes of the State are also eligible to apply under the scheme. The students are compulsorily required to apply online on the AICTE web portal http://www.aicte-jk-scholarship-gov.in/ and attend the Centralized Counseling.

5. EXCLUSIONS

Categories of students NOT eligible under the scheme are:

- · Students pursing courses through Open Universities.
- Students availing benefit of any other scholarship scheme.
- · Students gaining admission through 'management quota'.
- · Students pursuing Post Graduate level studies, in any discipline.

6. RESERVATION

The reservation norms as prescribed for the State of Jammu & Kashmir in respect of Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST) and Socially and Economically Backward Classes (SEBC) are followed for providing scholarships under the Scheme. The break-up is given below:-

- a. SC-8%
- b. ST-11%
 - (i) Gujjar & Backward 6%
 - (ii) Leh District 2%
 - (iii) Kargil District 2%
 - (iv) Other STs 1%
- c. Socially and Economically Backward Classes (SEBC) -25%
 - (i) Weak & under privileged classes (Social Caste) (OCS)-2%
 - (ii) Resident of Backward Area (RBA)-20%
 - (iii) Resident of adjoining Actual Line of Control (ALC) -3%

Horizontally, a reservation of 3% is provided for Persons with Disabilities (PwD) as per Central Government norms.

7. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Students must compulsorily apply online on AICTE's web portal- (http://www.aicte-jk-scholarship-gov.in/). The State Government of Jammu & Kashmir through various

facilitation centers, assist the students in submission of online application and verification of the following original documents to ascertain their eligibility under the scheme.

- (i) Certificate of domicile of the State of Jammu & Kashmir
- (ii) Certificate of Class 12th and 10th Examination (for candidates who have passed class 12th examination)
- (iii) Polytechnic Diploma Certificate (for Diploma candidates)
- (iv) Income Certificate
- (v) Students applying under reserved quota must produce Caste Certificate (SC/ST/SEBC) issued by State Government authority.
- (vi) Persons with Disabilities (PwD) must submit Disability Certificate

Merit list is generated based on Class XII results. The students, whose name appear in the merit list are compulsorily required to attend the counseling. Counseling is done for allotment for supernumerary seats created in institutions which are either approved by AICTE or Council of Architecture or Pharmacy Council of India or Indian Nursing Council or under Section 12B of UGC Act.

The details of supernumerary seats created are as follows:

- 10 (Ten) seats in Engineering stream (two seats per course subject to maximum of 10 seats per Institution)
- 2 (Two) seats per Institute in General streams (B.A/B.Com/B.Sc. etc). Limited to only those Institutes which are approved under section 12B of the UGC Act.
- Two/three seats in B.Sc. Nursing course in any Institute recognized by the Indian Nursing Council (INC).
- 2 (Two) seats in B. Architecture course in any Institute recognized by the Council of Architecture (CoA) subject to clearing the National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA).
- 2 (Two) seats in B. Pharmacy course in any Institute recognized by the Pharmacy Council of India.

Scholarship is approved under the scheme only to those students whose name appear in the merit list, have attended counseling and taken admission to either allotted institution or taken admission on their own in Central Universities or Medical/Engineering Colleges based on Government conducted National/State level examination.

8. DURATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarships granted under the scheme are renewed in subsequent classes subject to good conduct and maintenance of attendance as prescribed by the respective institution. Students who fail to get promoted to the next class/level for any reason, including illness, get the scholarship amount of that academic year in the following academic year, subject to the condition that he/she will get the scholarship for only the regular duration of the course (i.e. three years for General Degree Courses, four years for Professional/Technical Courses and five years for Medical Courses). Scholarship will not be paid twice for the same year of study.

9. SCHOLARSHIP DISBURSAL PROCEDURE:

The maintenance allowance component of scholarship is disbursed directly into the student's bank account through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) whereas the academic fee component is disbursed to the institute's bank account. From the academic session 2017-18, scholarship is being disbursed through Public Financial Management System (PFMS).

FRESH SCHOLARSHIP DISBURSAL PROCEDURE:

(i) Steps to be followed by students:

Students who are finally selected for award of scholarship must login on AICTE's Web Portal and proceed as follows:-

- 1. Click on 'Proceed for DBT' tab. Go through the instructions and then click on 'Proceed Further' tab to access DBT application.
- 2. Click on the 'Basic Details', 'Institute Details' and 'Bank Details' tabs and fill in all the necessary information.
- 3. Click on 'Attachments' tab and upload a scanned copy of the following documents:
 - · Joining Report
 - First page of Bank Pass book showing clearly the following details:
 - Account Holder's name
 - Account Number
 - IFSC Code
 - MICR Code
 - Bank Address
- 4. Click on 'Submit' tab after verifying all details and logout from the portal.
- 5. Student must then contact his/her college authorities for verification of DBT application.

(ii) Steps to be followed by Institutions:

Institutes admitting students under the Special Scholarship Scheme for Jammu and Kashmir should proceed as follows:

- (a) For Institutions admitting students under the Special Scholarship Scheme for the first time in academic year 2018-19:
- Login to the J&K admission portal and fill in all necessary information under 'Institute Details', 'Bank Details' and 'Fee Details'. Institutions should apply for a user 1D and password for the J&K admission portal at http://www.aicte-india.orgljnkadmissions 2017-18.php if they do not already have one.
- 2. Upload a scanned copy of the following documents:

- Mandate form in prescribed format (available at https://www.aicte-india.org/bureaus/jk/2017-2018)
- Academic Fee details in prescribed format (available at https://www.aicte-india.org/bureaus/jk/2017-2018)
- · State Fee Regulatory Committee (SFRC) document.
- · First page of Bank Pass book showing clearly the following details:
 - Account Holder's name
 - Account Number
 - IFSC Code
 - MICR Code
 - Bank Address
- 3. Proceed to 'Candidate Verification'. Verify the details of students one by one.
- (b) For Institutions who have previously admitted students under the Special Scholarship Scheme for Jammu and Kashmir:
- 1. Login to J&K admission portal and upload scanned copy of SFRC document for academic year 2018-19.
- 2. Proceed to 'Candidate Verification'. Verify the details of students one by one.

RENEWAL SCHOLARSHIP DISBURSAL PROCEDURE:

Students are required to upload the following documents after getting it verified from their institute.

- 1. Continuation Certificate signed by the head of institution.
- 2. Copy of Mark Sheet for the academic year towards which the scholarship is being claimed/previous semester result showing promotion to next academic year.

10. IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING

For better and effective implementation and monitoring of this Scheme, constitution of a Committee was recommended in CCEA note. Accordingly, a Committee – Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMC) – on Special Scholarship Scheme for Jammu & Kashmir was constituted. Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMC) is constituted to oversee the implementation of the Scheme and is Chaired by Secretary, Department of Higher Education. Adviser Project Appraisal and Management Division (PAMD) and Adviser Education, Planning Commission (NITI Aayog), representatives of Department of Expenditure are members and representatives of the Ministries of Social Justice & Empowerment, Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Deptt. of Science & Technology are invitees. Secretary (Higher Education) and Secretary (School Education), Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir are special invitees.

11. ASSOCIATION OF GOVT. OF J&K

For better coordination with the State Government, Secretary (Higher Education) and Secretary (School Education), Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir are co-opted as special invitees for the Inter-Ministerial Committee Meetings (IMC).

Facilitation Centre to facilitate the students with online applications & documents verification are set up by the State Govt. Further, the scheme is disseminated amongst the target group with the support of State Govt.

SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR THE STUDENTS OF JAMMU & KASHMIR DURING ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19

ABOUT THE SCHEME:

The scheme envisages to build capacities of the youth of J&K to enable them to compete in the normal course. Scholarship is awarded to meet the expenditure towards Academic Fees and Maintenance Allowances (for hostel, mess, cost of books and other incidental charges) to students who are admitted through AICTE's counseling process.

1. NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIP, ACADEMIC FEE & MAINTENANCE CHARGES:

- Scholarship towards academic fee will be reimbursed directly to Institution as per actual or as per norms laid down by State Fee Regulatory Authority or fixed under PMSSS, whichever is less and within overall ceiling of the guidelines.
- The ceiling for maintenance charges will be Rs. 1.00 lakh per annum and will be paid through PFMS mechanism in students account directly in two equal instalments of Rs. 50,000/- each.
- Second or subsequent instalments will be released subject to submission of promotion letter duly signed by the Head of the Institution.
- Expenditure towards maintenance charges for hostel, mess, cost of books and other incidental charges will be credited to the student bank account directly.

Note: Saving Bank Account should be seeded with Aadhaar Number and in the name of the bonafide student. Students may note that Bank Accounts should not be a "Nofrill Account" /Minor Account, Parents' Account /Non-Operative etc.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

* Students having domicile of Jammu & Kashmir and have passed 12th examination

- from J&K Board or CBSE affiliated schools located in J&K in academic year 2017-18 or 2016-17 only.
- ❖ Students who wants to take admission under Lateral Entry Scheme have to pass Diploma in Engineering from the Polytechnic Institute recognised by J&K during AY not earlier than 2016-17. Admission under Lateral Entry Scheme will be subject to vacant seats available during academic year 2017-18 in Engineering Stream only.
- Common merit list will be prepared for students who register themselves on portal of AICTE for allotment of seats during counseling for academic year 2018-19.
- Having family income of Rs. 8.00 Lakh or less per annum.

3. INSTITUTES / COLLEGES PARTICIPATING:

- Admission will be offered to the students in selected pool of well performing institutions / colleges / universities, which are recognized by AICTE or approved by UGC under Section 12(B) or respective Regulatory Bodies of Government of India only, which are fulfilling following additional criteria:
- All the NAAC and NBA accredited institute/colleges having hostel facilities and given their willingness to offer admissions.
- All AICTE approved institutions having atleast 50% enrolment in the North and North-Western States (Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Chandigarh, Haryana, Delhi, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand) and with atleast 80% or more enrolment admissions in the rest of the country excluding J&K State with having:
- a) Zero deficiency on AICTE portal for academic year 2018-19.
- b) Hostel facility.
- c) Placement of their students minimum 30% in last three years.

3.1 ADMISSION IN IITs'/ NITs' and OTHER INSTITUTIONS OF NATIONAL IMPORTANCE:

- Aspirants desire to take admission through JEE Mains/JEE Advance in IIT's, NIT's, IISC, IISER and centrally funded institutions with national importance may be considered, if student participate in online counselling by filling their JEE Mains/JEE Advance roll numbers with respective admit card and result.
- ❖ All Medical aspirants seeking admission in BDS/MBBS streams have to appear in NEET examinations whereas they can register on portal by submitting their complete details including NEET roll number and get their documents verified by Facilitation Centre as per the procedure. Further, after securing there admission to college through NEET central counselling, they may upload their admission letter and NEET score card to become eligible for the scholarship.
- * Aspirants seeking admission in Architecture programme have to qualify NATA and

their admission to Architecture through portal would be confirmed after uploading their NATA result and admit card.

3.2 EXCLUSIONS:

Categories of Students NOT eligible under the PMSSS. These are

- a) Students pursing courses through Open Universities.
- b) Student already availing benefit of PMSSS / other scholarships schemes.
- c) Students gaining admission through 'Management Quota'.
- d) Students pursuing Post Graduate level studies, in any discipline.
- e) Students having family income over Rs. 8.00 Lakh per annum.
- f) Not applied through online registration in the AICTE Portal.
- g) Taking admission in the Colleges other than the prescribed colleges given in AICTE Portal.
- h) Admission through Agents / NGOs.
- i) Students admitted to institution / courses which is neither approved under 12(B) of UGC Act or AICTE or by respective regulatory body.

4. ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCESS DURING ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19

A. Admission under 10+2 Scheme

Students who have passed 12th examination from J&K Board or CBSE affiliated schools located in J&K in the academic year 2017-18 and 2016-17 can only submit their application on AICTE Portal for registration. Candidates are advised to fill exact particulars as furnished at the time of registration for class 12th examination. Students whose credentials do not match with the particulars available in AICTE-portal will not be able to register online. On successful registration, eligible students will be issued username and password to fill online form on AICTE Portal.

B. Admission under Lateral Entry Scheme

Al the eligible diploma passed students in Engineering from the Polytechnic Institutes affiliated with J&K State Technical Board during AY 2016-17 onwards have to follow same procedure for registration, verification of documents and choice filling. The availability of seats is based on the vacancy in Engineering stream in AY 2017-18 under PMSSS.

4.1 STEPS TO BE TAKEN DURING REGISTRATION:

Students would be required to upload the following documents:

- a) Passport Size photograph (200 x 230 pixels preferred)
- b) Scanned Signature (140 x 60 pixels preferred)
- c) Domicile certificate issued by J&K Government
- d) SSC Marksheet
- e) Family income certificate (Issued by Tehsildar or equivalent)
- f) Aadhaar Card (if any)
- g) Category certificate (issued by the Competent Authority of the State Government)
- h) Persons with Disabilities (PwD) must upload Disability Certificate.
- i) Students who are already availing the benefits of PMSSS are not eligible to apply.
- Student is required to give preference of the course which he / she intend to pursue i.e.
 General or Professional or Medical stream.
- General Stream includes admission to B.A./B.Com./B.Sc./B.Sc.(Hon.), BBA/BCA / B.Sc. (Physiotherapy), B.Sc.(Agriculture) etc.
- Professional courses include B.E./B.Tech./ B. Pharmacy /B. Architecture/Hotel Management & Catering Technology/ B.Sc.(Nursing).
- Medical Streams include MBBS / B.D.S./BAMS and allied medicinal courses.

4.2 DOCUMENT VERIFICATION and CHOICE FILLING:

The applicant is required to get his / her uploaded documents verified with the originals at the nearest Facilitation Centres set-up by Government of J&K and once it got verified and uploaded with stamp on portal of Facilitation Centres. The choice filling window would be activated for only those candidates having successfully registered and got there documents verified at any one of the Facilitation Centres. The choice filling window will be blocked on the last date, after that no change would be allowed in order of preference. After document verification from the facilitation center the candidate should collect the copy of document verification report without fail.

4.3 COUNSELING MECHANISM:

- Allotment of all the scholarships will be done through online counseling only.
- No admission will be allowed in any circumstances without participation in online counselling and colleges available for choice filling.
- List of Institutions / Universities where admissions offered would be prepared and will be displayed on website of AICTE. Eligible students under the Scheme are directed to choose the courses from these Institutions/ Universities only. It may be noted that no

scholarship will be paid to the students who take admission in other than the list of Institutions/ Universities available on the portal of AICTE except MBBS/ BDS or allied medicinal courses for which supernumerary quota is not available.

Merit list of students based on the marks obtained in CBSE/JK Bose will be displayed well before the first round of counselling result.

5. RESERVATION:

The reservation norms as prescribed for the State of J&K in respect of SC, ST and Socially and Economically Backward Classes (SEBC) are followed for providing scholarship under the Scheme. The break-up is given below:-

b)ST - 11%

- (i) Gujjar & Backward 6%
- (ii) Leh District 2%
- (iii) Kargil District 2%

6.1 MAINTENANCE FEE




