Name of the University: Symbiosis Skills and Open University, Pune

List of Approvals : Symbiosis Skills and Open University, Pune is a self-financed University established vide Symbiosis Skills and Open University Act, 2017 enacted by Govt. of Maharashtra under Act No(Mah. Act No. XXXVII of 2017), dated 03.05.2017and approved by UGC.

2. Name and List of Scholarship Schemes (Government or Private) for students from Jammu and Kashmir to take admission in your University.

The admission criteria for various programs offered by Symbiosis Skills and Open University for all Indian students (including students for Jammu and Kashmir) are as under.

I. B.Tech programs:

B.Tech in Automobile Engineering B.Tech in Mechatronics Engineering B.Tech in Construction Engineering and Management

 Passed 10+2 examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the following subjects namely Chemistry / Biotechnology / Biology / Technical Vocational subject. Obtained at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidate belonging to reserved category) in the above subjects taken together.

OR

Passed Diploma (in Engineering and Technology) examination with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category)

OR

Passed 10 + 2 year full time vocational education course offered by MSBVE as per GR - VOC - 2012/591/25A/dtd. 28^{th} Sept. 2012.

- Obtained at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category, in case of reserved categories and Persons with Disability candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only) in the above subjects taken together.
- If student has not appeared for any state / national level entrance exam for admission to B.Tech. Program, he / she is required to appear for entrance test conducted by respective engineering schools of SSOU.
- · While deciding the eligibility of the Candidates following procedure shall be adopted-

(a) The percentage of marks shall be calculated by rounding off to nearest integer. i.e. if the percentage of marks comes out to be 44.50% to 44.99% then it shall be rounded to 45% and if the percentage of marks comes out to be 44.01% to 44.49% shall be rounded to 44% for deciding the eligibility.

(b) In case the maximum marks in an individual subject is other than 100, the marks will be converted out of 100 for individual subject without rounding, If sum of the converted marks of individual subjects without rounding off works out to be a figure

with fraction then fraction up to two decimal places shall only be considered for calculation of percentage of marks considering maximum marks as 300 and, If the percentage comes in fraction, then rounding off shall be done as above to decide the eligibility.

II. BBA Programs

BBA in Ports and Terminal Management BBA in Retail Management BBA in Logistics and Supply Chain Management

- Passed XII (10+2) or equivalent course in any discipline from any recognized Board/Council/University with minimum 50% marks for general (open) category and 45% marks for students of reserved category.
- Candidates are selected based on Personal interview conducted by the University.
- · While deciding the eligibility of the Candidates following procedure shall be adopted-
 - The percentage of marks shall be calculated by rounding off to nearest integer.
 i.e. if the percentage of marks comes out to be 49.50% to 49.99% then it shall be rounded to 50% and if the percentage of marks comes out to be 49.01% to 49.49% shall be rounded to 49% for deciding the eligibility.
 - In case the maximum marks in an individual subject is other than 100, the marks will be converted out of 100 for individual subject without rounding, If sum of the converted marks of individual subjects without rounding off works out to be a figure with fraction then fraction up to two decimal places shall only be considered for calculation of percentage of marks considering maximum marks as 300 and, If the percentage comes in fraction, then rounding off shall be done as above to decide the eligibility.

III. Bachelor of Architecture (B.Arch)

The candidate must have passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination recognized by Central/State Government with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also 50% marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination.

OR

10+3 Diploma Examination recognized by Central/State Government with Mathematics as compulsory subject, with at least 50% marks in aggregate.

Candidates must have a valid NATA (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) score conducted by Council of Architecture (COA) or JEE Mains Paper II score.

While deciding the eligibility of the Candidates following procedure shall be adopted-

- a. Eligibility will be calculated with the weightage of 50% marks for aptitude tests and 50% marks in the qualifying examination.
- b. The percentage of marks shall be calculated by rounding off to nearest integer. i.e. if the percentage of marks comes out to be 44.50% to 44.99% then it shall be rounded to 45% and if the percentage of marks comes out to be 44.01% to 44.49% shall be rounded to 44% for deciding the eligibility.
- c. In case the maximum marks in an individual subject is other than 100, the marks will be converted out of 100 for individual subject without rounding, If sum of the converted marks of individual subjects without rounding off works out to be a figure with fraction then fraction up to two decimal places shall only be considered for calculation of percentage of marks considering maximum marks as 300 and, If the percentage comes in fraction, then rounding off shall be done as above to decide the eligibility.

IV. B.Sc in Beauty & Wellness

- Passed XII (10+2) or equivalent course in any discipline from any recognized Board/Council/University.
- Candidates are selected based on Personal interview conducted by the University.

While deciding the eligibility of the Candidates following procedure shall be adopted-

- a. The percentage of marks shall be calculated by rounding off to nearest integer. i.e. if the percentage of marks comes out to be 44.50% to 44.99% then it shall be rounded to 45% and if the percentage of marks comes out to be 44.01% to 44.49% shall be rounded to 44% for deciding the eligibility.
- b. In case the maximum marks in an individual subject is other than 100, the marks will be converted out of 100 for individual subject without rounding, If sum of the converted marks of individual subjects without rounding off works out to be a figure with fraction then fraction up to two decimal places shall only be considered for calculation of percentage of marks considering maximum marks as 300 and, If the percentage comes in fraction, then rounding off shall be done as above to decide the eligibility.

V. B.Sc in Data Science

Passed XII (10+2) or equivalent course with Mathematics as compulsory subject with minimum 50% marks for general (open) category and 45% marks for students of reserved category.

VI. PG Diploma in Dietetics

- B.Sc. In Beauty and Wellness with Specialization in Wellness.
- B.Sc. with Home Science / Family and Community Science / Nutrition & Dietetics / Food Science & Nutrition / Food Service Management and Dietetics / Food Quality Control / Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics with Chemistry / Biochemistry at additional level and all group of Life science in UG level (Botany, Zoology, Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Microbiology and Chemistry).Bachelor of Nursing from any University, B. Pharma Degree OR BSc. Nursing, MBBS Degree

VII. PGD in Data Science & AI

• Graduate or post graduate with good numerical and analytical skills, minimum 50% at graduate exam, orientation to mathematical subjects during graduate or post graduate studies, work experience preferred

OR

- IT professional with 2 years of experience in software development or databases and having successfully completed courses in Linear Algebra and Statistics
- Applicants will be interviewed and selected

5. If a student pass out his / her 12th (Physics, Chemistry, Math) from National Board of School Education, Jammu and Kashmir (<u>www.nbse.in</u>), what are the various course options in your University for him/ her.

For obtaining admission to any of the Undergraduate or Postgraduate program offered by Symbiosis Skills and Open University, the student shall have obtained minimum required qualifications from recognized board / University as per the eligibility norms.

If National Board of School Education, Jammu and Kashmir is vested with the authority to conduct examinations at school level and for certification thereof by concerned regulatory authorities; then students who have passed out 12th examination with Physics, Chemistry, Maths subjects from National Board of School Education, Jammu and Kashmir may opt for following programs offered by Symbiosis Skills and Open University provided they fulfill minimum eligibility norms prescribed.
